



Geography LTP (Rolling Plan)

EYFS and KS1 follow a 2-year rolling plan. The same topics are taught in Mars and Venus to ensure an equitable learning experience for the split Year 1 cohort. In EYFS, the enhanced provision is linked to the KS1 geography topics as appropriate to enable them to begin their learning journey in this subject.

Year 3-5 follow a 3-year rolling plan. The same topics are taught in Neptune and Saturn to ensure an equitable learning experience for the split Year 4 cohort whilst avoiding repetition of topics.
